



# STARKILLER BASE



## Environmental Impact Statement

### **Purpose:**

Starkiller Base will be constructed to end a regime that acquiesces to disorder. The new fierce machine will bring an ended to the Senate and force systems to bow to the First Order.

### **Environmental Impact of Proposed Action:**

Starkiller Base will require excavating an equatorial trench approximately 581 miles deep, 1,500 miles across, and 12,000 miles long in an 180 degree arch across the surface of the planet.
